



Dear Parent/Guardian,

Anti-Social Behaviour – Putting the Community First.

I would like to make you aware of a rise in incidents of anti-social behaviour following complaints received from the public regarding anti-social behaviour and crime caused by young people in the area of **Norris Green Park, Lorenzo Drive Norris Green.**

These incidents have included damage being caused to property and vehicles, people being intimidated, violence and fires being set alight. Some of these incidents amount to criminal offences and are being treated as such.

Merseyside Police and Merseyside Fire and Rescue Service are working closely with schools in the area, and increasing partols in the area to monitor and appropriately tackle these issues.

What you can do to help.....

Make young people aware of the dangers of this type of behaviour and the impact it has on our local communities and their future.

If you are responsible for a young person, ensure you know where they are and what they're doing whilst out.
