Please read the following Information carefully as there are several points of important information for you.

1. BTEC/Technical examinations
 - As you may be aware from the updates from DfE on Tuesday evening regarding the current vocational examination series, the decision as to whether the exams will run or not has been left in the hands of school leaders. In light of the current lockdown and restrictions in place and on the grounds of health and safety, we have taken the difficult decision to cancel all upcoming BTEC examinations in the current series.
 - We appreciate this may be disappointing as we are aware pupils have spent time preparing for their exams, however the decision has been made on the grounds of public health and the safety and well-being of our pupils, staff and their families.
 - As a result of this decision there are NO examinations during January and February for BTEC/Tech award courses.

2. Mock exams/Remote learning
 - We know some of you have been asking about the mock exams which were scheduled to begin on Monday 8th February. As we will still be under lockdown restrictions at this point, these exams will not start on this date.
 - It is important students continue to keep up with their work as we will reschedule some form of assessments when school opens.
 - Please ensure students are logging into class charts daily and attending any live lessons scheduled through Microsoft TEAMS
