UPDATE ON PE KIT - YR 9

As part of our enhanced procedures in response to the COVID-19 pandemic update and latest government guidelines for schools, we have changed some of the arrangements for physical education (PE) from Monday 15th March (week 1).

The details are as follows:

- Children in **Year 9** should come to school in St John Bosco PE kit **under** their blazer on their PE days, even if they are injured, feel they can't fully participate practically.
 - Trainers
 - Black socks (spare pair in case socks get wet from being outside)
 - St John Bosco PE top
 - St John Bosco PE shorts
 - St John Bosco PE Fleece (*optional*)
 - Plain black leggings (*optional*)
 - **Plain black** sports sweatshirt, plain black waterproof sports jacket (*optional*)
- PE lessons will continue to be outdoors as much as possible (rain won't stop us learning, unless it is torrential) or in the large sports hall to ensure good ventilation and adequate space.
- Blazers will be removed for the PE lesson and left in pupil classrooms.

Maintaining high standards of uniform is an important part of the St John Bosco Arts College aspirations, our school PE kit is an extension of our uniform and reflects our identity as a team, community and encourages students to take pride in themselves and their school. Students must **not** wear any item of clothing with large logos or any other colour than black.
