

Year 10 - Returning to School.

From Monday 29th June you will be returning to school for some face to face time with the teachers.

Lunch

On the days that you are in for this week, you will not need to bring in a lunch as you will go home in time for this.

On the following week, (week beginning 6th July) you will need to bring a packed lunch unless you are free school meals, in which case you will be given a school lunch.

Uniform and equipment

When you are in school you will need to wear your uniform, **but not** your blazer. This should be left at home.

Bring as little as possible into school. You will only need your pencil case and a snack for your break

Starting and finishing school

You will have been given a start time and a finish time.

You must arrive in time for your first lesson at the time you have been given.

Once your lessons are finished you **must** go straight home. You are not allowed to hang around on site or stay behind.

Arriving at and leaving school

If coming to school on public transport, you **must** wear a mask unless you are exempt (don't have to) from wearing one

When you arrive at school there will be a cordon as you come through the school gate, a bit like what you may have seen at the supermarket. This is to help you keep at a 2m distance from your peers.

You will have a specific door that you will use to enter and exit the school building. You must only come into and leave school by this door.

Once in school you will have to wash your hands and then use the hand sanitiser before you go to your classroom.

Once in school

Once you have washed and sanitised your hands, your teacher will take you to the classroom where you will have your lessons.

You will only go to **one** room for your lessons and will be given your own desk, where you will work for that day. The teachers will come to you, you **will not** change rooms.

You can wear a mask in school if you want to wear one. Some students may choose to wear a mask and others may choose not to. This will be the same for the teachers.

If you need the toilet, you will only be allowed to go one at a time to go into toilets. There will be a teacher on duty who will make sure only one person goes in. The toilets will be cleaned regularly and you must wash your hands after visiting the toilet.



You will enter via the back of the building as normal.

The door that you use to enter school will be labelled.



There will be markers and arrows on the floor to help you keep 2m apart.



Signs around the building will remind you to wash your hands on a regular basis.



All desks will be 2m apart. You cannot sit anywhere other than at your desk.
