Dear Parent/Carer

During Year 9, Design Technology students will study two different subject areas; food technology and textiles technology. Students will spend half of the academic year in each subject area.

In food technology students will be learning about food trends and dietary requirements. As part of the project students will take part in a number of practical lessons to develop key technical skills to become an independent learner. The dishes students will be cooking are: crispy chicken bites, beef burgers, muffins, chicken gyros, Indian style chip butty, vegan lemon cake, healthy loaded fries, gluten free brownie and will plan their own dish as part of a final assessment.

Students will need a large container for every practical lesson to take food home. Ingredients will be provided by the school however students will be given the opportunity to bring in optional extra ingredients for some practical lessons and will be told in advance of the lesson.

When working in textiles technology students will be introduced to embroidery, pattern making and will continue to develop sewing machine skills. Students will design and make a festival themed bag and will use a variety of different materials. Students will take home the final bag at the end of the project.

To support the department with providing ingredients and materials, we ask for a one-off contribution payment of £12. This can be paid through parent pay by Tuesday 11th October.
