Dear Parent/Carer

We are very pleased your child has chosen to study Hospitality and Catering as part of the KS4 options. In preparation for the unit 2 cooking exam your child will make a variety of dishes to support the development of their practical skills.

In previous school years we have asked parents/careers to purchase ingredients for your child to bring this to each lesson when needed. As the school can purchase ingredients at wholesale prices, this year we are giving parents/careers the opportunity to either purchase ingredients for their child or make a one-off payment of £50 for school to order the ingredients for all practical the lessons within year 10. We feel it will be more cost effective for yourself than buying ingredients separately for each practical.

As part of unit 2 your child will learn new skills for example; filleting a fish, portioning a chicken, making a roux and bread making. Your child will also develop other skills asked from the exam board and make a number of new dishes. The dishes your child will be making during year 10 are:
