1. **Arrival:** Please arrive at the school between 8:00 AM and 11:00 AM. Upon arrival, enter through the main reception. Here you will be directed to the designated area where results will be distributed.
2. **Collection:** Parents/Carers are welcome to attend with you to collect your results. If you are unable to collect your results in person, you may authorise a representative to do so on your behalf. Your representative must bring a signed authorisation letter from you and their own identification. Please inform us prior to results day if someone else will be collecting your results for you.
3. **Queries, Support and Next Steps:** Staff members, will be available on results day to provide support and answer any questions you may have about your results and next steps. For those of you who need guidance, whether it's relating to university places further education, apprenticeships, or career choices, we will be available to offer personalised advice and support.
