Attendance and Punctuality

In order to reach their full potential, a high level of attendance is vital for pupils. We rely on the support of parents and carers to send their children in EVERYDAY, on time, unless the reason for absence is unavoidable.

Daily routine for pupils:

08:00	School opens with FREE breakfast items for ALL students - Passive supervision	
08:30	Students attend morning registration (registers taken at 08:35)	
08:35 -08:55	Students who arrive between these times will need to enter the school via the main entrance and sign in using the school InVentry system. They will receive a late mark and complete a 20-minute detention at lunch time	
After 08:55	Students who arrive after 08:55 will need to enter the school via the main entrance and sign in using the school InVentry system. They will receive a late mark and complete a 1-hour detention after school.

Uniform Standards


I would like to remind all families that the expectations of students' uniform must be met as outlined in the Uniform Policy which can be found here.

Uniform Swap Shop

For all students, a supply of clean, good quality pre-loved items are available to all. Parents/carers are asked to consider donating and collecting pre-loved items; as well as the financial benefits, this reduces clothing waste and helps the environment.

Jewellery

Students are permitted to wear one plain pair of simple studs in the lobe of the ear as part of the school uniform. Students are not permitted to wear any other jewellery, including necklaces and bracelets. If a student attends school wearing jewellery that is not permitted, they will be required to remove the jewellery, place it in an envelope and it will be stored in the PPC's safe until it can be collected at the end of the day. Failure to follow these rules will result in the use of the school behaviour policy. Please see the diagram below and do not hesitate to contact the school if parents/carers have any questions.





Nail Varnish/Fake Nails/ False Eyelashes

Nail varnish and any type of fake nails and eyelashes are **not** permitted at St John Bosco. Please ensure that any of the above are removed before students return for the start of the new school year.

Mobile Phones and Technology

Mobile phones and other technology, such as wireless headphones, must be placed in student lockers at the start of the day and not collected until the school day has concluded. Failure to follow this rule will lead to students being issued with a 1-hour detention after school.
